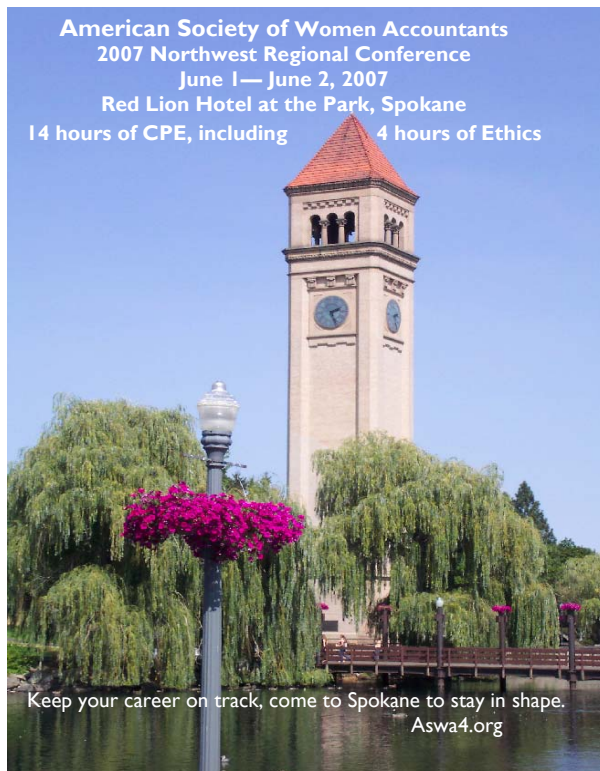
President's Message
